Strategies for Supporting Your Child

This presentation will begin by putting you inside the shoes of a child with a learning disability or a child who struggles in school. While you may initially discover (or be reminded) how it feels to struggle with aspects of learning, you'll quickly be given tools and subject specific strategies to help your child with the learning process.

You will likely discover some of the incredibly clever ways in which your child is already working through learning challenges and what you can do to help your child achieve his or her best potential!

Sarah Bieber is a former high school resource teacher who is passionate about helping students who struggle with learning. This passion began at a young age, as Sarah helped her five younger siblings who were diagnosed with learning disabilities with their schoolwork.

On top of her high school teaching experience, Sarah has worked in a junior high school resource room and as a private tutor, gaining one-on-one experience helping dozens of students who struggle with various aspects of learning.

Now, as the parent of a child with a learning disability, Sarah has been able to put her experience to work in her own home as she helps him find success at school. She continues to regularly research the subject of learning, through books, articles and practical experience, in order to better help her own child and those around her.

Sarah currently volunteers as an educational consultant to assist parents in developing strategies that are specific to their child's learning needs.

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
